AIMS OF THE COURSE

WHY STUDY THIS COURSE?

- This course is offered as a National Diploma (2 A Level equivalent) or an Extended Diploma (3 A Level equivalent)
- This course provides a variety of pathways into Higher Education at University or into employment

ASSESSMENT

- This course is assessed through examination (E), controlled assessment (CA) or coursework for each unit.
- Coursework can be in the form of reports, essays, presentations or other formats (C).





Coursework is delivered through assignments which are set and marked by your teacher(s).
