

Completing the UCAS application.

You need to complete all of the following sections before attending an afterschool session. Follow the guidance under each heading to do so.

Personal details.

Should be self-explanatory! Ensure you give yourself capital letters for your name.

Contact and Residency.

Area of permanent residence is asking for your borough e.g. Greenwich, Lewisham (not City of London: that means St Pauls/Bank etc!)

Nationality

Ensure nationality here matches what you put in the Residential Category above.

If a dual national with UK citizenship, but UK national first.

Settled Status question only refers to EU citizens who have settled or pre-settled status: select 'No' if this does not apply to you.

Supporting information:

This is asking if you have ever lived in an EU country, or if your parents/carers are EU nationals.

English language skills:

As long as you have completed some education in the UK e.g. from GCSE English to Sixth Form subjects, you can select 'Yes'

Finance and Funding:

Almost all of you will select the second option "UK, ChI, IoM or EU student finance services".

For next question enter your borough again.

Diversity and inclusion.

Parental education is important as a widening participation criteria. If you can truthfully say No, meaning your parents/carers are not university graduates, then this can be to your advantage. If one of them graduated from university in the UK or elsewhere, select Yes.

More about you.

These are important questions to ensure universities can make contextual offers were appropriate. Ensure you answer them all accurately.

Education.

Put in Tallis and other secondary schools if appropriate.

Enter all your GCSE grades. You will need the exam boards. Select August and correct year for 'date awarded'.

Enter Extended Project if appropriate.

Enter current subjects, exam boards, next August for date awarded, and grade as 'Pending'.
Do not include Modules.

Single BTEC = Extended Certificate; Double = Diploma; Triple = Extended Diploma

Include BTEC registration number if appropriate (can get from Exams Office); do not need ULN

Can enter other qualifications if appropriate e.g. Music grades.

For the question 'Please state the highest level of qualification you expect to have before you start your course', select 'Below honours degree level qualifications'

Employment

Not needed, but include paid employment if you like.

Extra activities

Read the details and include anything relevant. Open Days are NOT relevant.
