### Hayward Gallery, Southbank

We have organised an art trip on Thursday, 15 September to visit the Hayward Gallery as part of the Young London Print Prize programme.

The purpose of this programme is to teach the students critical professional skills. They will work with other students from across the borough and contribute to the development of a major new report on climate art published on the eve of COP27, and judge 1,500 submissions to the Young London Print Prize with their choices (the winners) then showcased live on the Piccadilly Lights. Through this process, the students will grow as individuals, enjoy and express themselves, and understand more clearly the career options available to them in the world of contemporary art.

The workshop will run from 13:00 – 15:00 and will include the following

Students will meet in room O105 at 11.20. We will travel by train, leaving school at 11.25 and walking to Kidbrooke station. We intend to return to school by 16:00. This trip is not a requirement of the curriculum, and it is voluntary, but such journeys are invariably of great educational and social value to the students.
