Correction to previous letter, please read - Art portfolio submission

Dear Student

In order to apply for the A-level Fine Art or the BTEC Extended Diploma courses at Thomas Tallis School you need to submit a portfolio of your work. Even if you have studied GCSE Fine Art here last year you are still required to submit a portfolio. The A Level Fine Art course at the school is a linear course over two years. We do not offer AS Fine Art. You will need to have a 6 or above at GCSE level for the A Level course and a 5 or above for the BTEC. In the previous letter it stated a level 6 was required for Btec – this is incorrect.

You will be encouraged to develop:

- intellectual, imaginative, creative and intuitive capabilities
- investigative, analytical, experimental, practical, technical and expressive skills, aesthetic understanding and critical judgement
- independence of mind in developing, refining and communicating your own ideas, your own intentions and your own personal outcomes
- an interest in, enthusiasm for and enjoyment of visual art
- the experience of working with a broad range of media

Portfolio submission

- Choose an artist whose work you admire.
What do you find interesting about his/her art works? Add a gallery of his/her work and annotate about the images.
- A selection of your course work and exam unit practical pieces, these should include final pieces and sketchbook pages.
