Replying to UCAS offers – please support us in asking your child not to reply yet

If your child has all their offers, they may be being pressed to reply by universities. However, there is no advantage to your child in replying early. It is better to reply later when grade outcomes are more precisely known and after a 'reply strategy' has been checked with UCAS staff. Please ask your child to heed our advice.

Are still possible. Please ask your child to speak with UCAS staff if they wish to apply. Students can apply to UCAS and still apply for an apprenticeship or Art College.
