Congratulations on receiving a conditional offer to study at Thomas Tallis Sixth Form September 2022-2024.

- The experience of working with a broad range of media.

- Please submit a series of 20 photographs.
- Please avoid clichés (e.g., sunsets, flowers, children, animals, etc.) Be creative. Try to make your photographs stand out.
- Add an evaluation of the photographs.
- What was the subject matter or theme? Why did you choose this topic, style, process, technique etc.?
