Dear Student

In order to apply for the A-level photography course at Thomas Tallis School you need to submit a portfolio of your work. Even if you have studied photography here last year you are still required to submit a portfolio. This year we can only offer 20 places. The A-level photography course at the school is a linear course over two years. We do not offer AS photography.

You will be encouraged to develop:

- intellectual, imaginative, creative and intuitive capabilities
- investigative, analytical, experimental, practical, technical and expressive skills, aesthetic understanding and critical judgement
- independence of mind in developing, refining and communicating your own ideas, your own intentions and your own personal outcomes
- an interest in, enthusiasm for and enjoyment of photography
- the experience of working with a broad range of media

Portfolio submission

1. Choose a photographer whose work you admire.
What do you find interesting about his/her images? Add a gallery of his/her work and annotate the images.
2. Please submit a series of 20 related photographs.
Please avoid clichés (e.g. sunsets, flowers, children, animals, etc.) Be creative. Try to make your photographs stand out.
3. Add an evaluation of the photographs
What was the subject matter or theme? Why did you choose this topic, style, process, technique etc.?
