- 1 Review the flipped learning programme covered in class. Go over the material again, using Cornell notes or filecards to capture the information.
- 2 Post questions on the Chat Forum for others to consider and respond to others' questions.
- 3 Review past exam questions and practice timed responses.
- 4 Create study cards.
- 5 Make wall posters related to each subtopic.
- 6 At the end of every week, review the lesson content for that week. At the end of every month, review the lesson content for that month. At the end of every term, review...
- 7 Review your notes on topics that you recently felt were the most challenging for you. Ask for help if you need it.
- 8 Self-test every week, month, term. Can you make a *brain dump* for each part of the syllabus that's 100% accurate?
- 9 Read the Economist every week and connect articles to study topics. Take notes on key vocabulary, phraseology and viewpoints.
